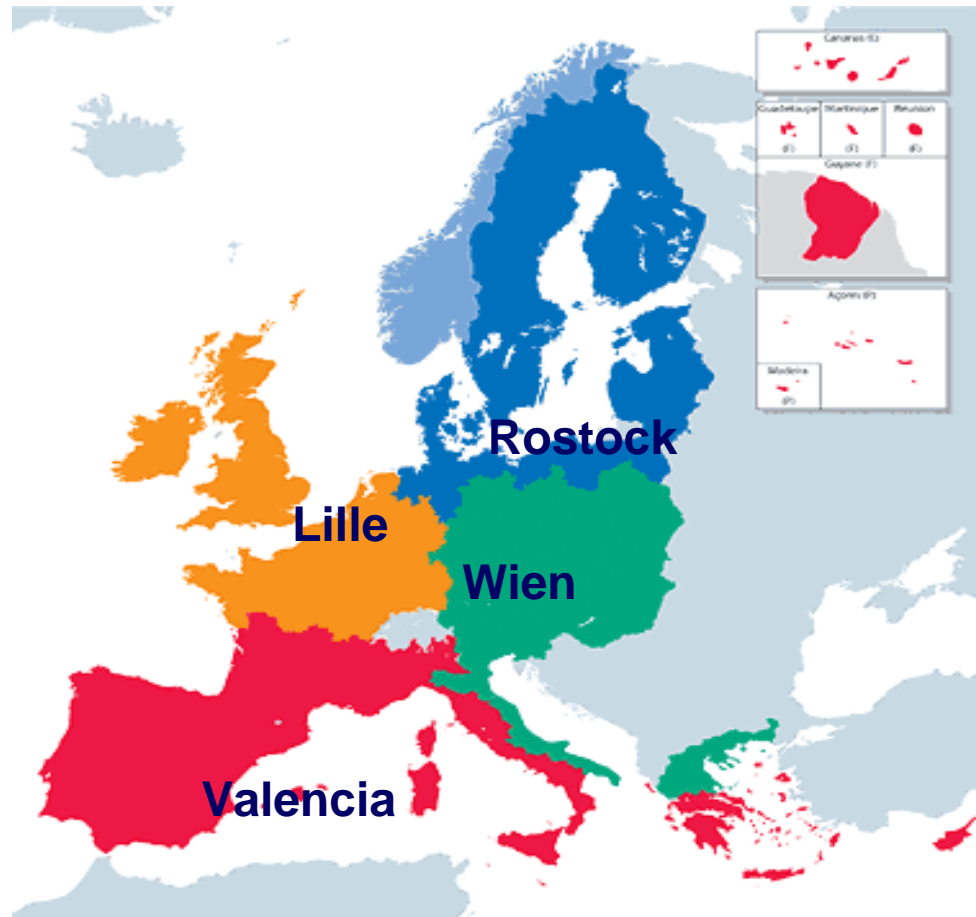

West: Lille, France

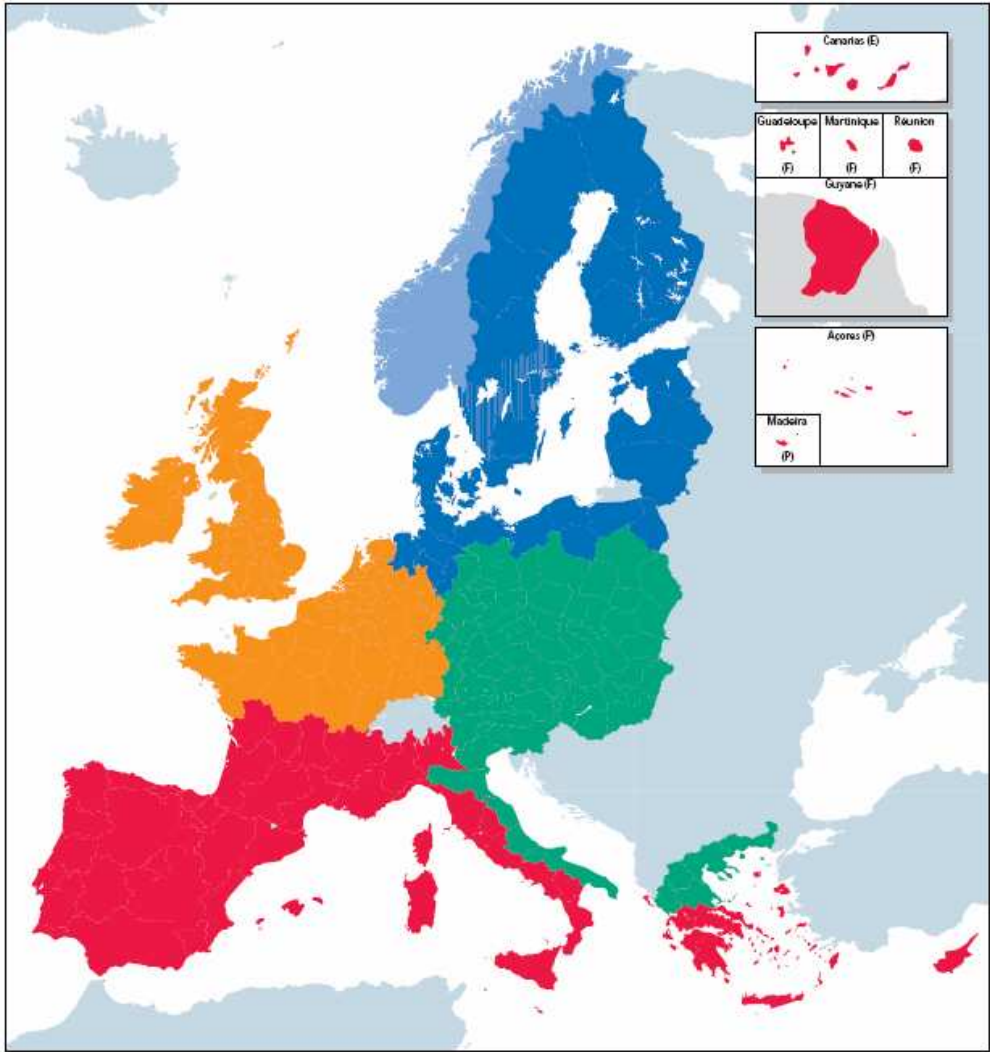
